

Update:

Our office wants to update you on some redistricting we have been working on. Each voter is assigned a Voting Precinct, Commissioner Precinct, JP and Constable Precincts, along with if you live in the city limits, and which school district you are in. All of these have very different boundary lines. In the past we had to use paper maps to see these lines and that made it very difficult to see the boundary lines. We attained new software this year, to help us make sure everyone's information is correct, and up to date. You will be receiving a new voter registration card, for 2026-2027, around the first of the year. So, be sure you check your new card to see if your voting precinct has been changed. That will be very important when you go to vote in the 2026 Primary. We know, no one likes change, but we are making sure everyone is voting in the right precincts.
